

Public Camping dos and don'ts

To ensure that the event runs as smooth as possible, and everybody has a great time, we ask that everyone abides by the following guidelines and rules whilst setting up or staying over.

1. Your booking allows access to the Cumbria Steam Gathering from 09.00 hrs on Friday July 25th and covers your camping pitch plus access to both days of the rally. Pitches must be vacated by 12noon on Monday July 28th.
2. Camping is next to vehicles.
3. No electrical hookups are available.
4. Camping is in fields, no hard standing is available.
5. There are toilets on site
6. Dogs are allowed but must be kept on leads at all times. Any mess made please clean it up.
7. Caravans, motor homes, trailer tents and tents are all allowed.
8. No fireworks.
9. No glass.
10. No bonfires.
11. No Fire Pits
12. BBQ'S are permitted, please use the receptacles provided for used disposable BBQs
13. No unauthorised vehicles, i.e. quads, mini-motos or electric scooters.
14. Cycling is prohibited during the hours of public access Saturday & Sunday 10.00 to 17.00hrs.
15. No driving around site past 9pm.
16. No music, loud disruption past 11pm.
17. Diesel and Petrol generators are allowed on site. Generators must be turned off between 11pm and 8am, organizers reserve the right to request generators be turned off at any time if deemed to be disturbing other campers.
18. A no vehicle movement policy is in place during the hours of public opening (Saturday and Sunday 10.00 to 17.00hrs)
19. Entrance gates will be locked between the hours of 23.00 and 07.00hrs from Thursday July 24th
